Emera Brunswick Pipeline and NB Power to Hold Joint Mock Emergency Exercise

Saint John, N.B. – Emera New Brunswick, owner and operator of the Brunswick Pipeline and NB Power will be participating in an emergency training exercise on Thursday, September 15, 2022, with local emergency responders. The exercise will take place between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm near Peacock Lane in Saint John, New Brunswick.

Emera New Brunswick and NB Power place the utmost importance on safety. During this exercise, we will work closely with a broad group of stakeholders to test emergency response plans and interagency communications practices in a simulated emergency scenario. Training exercises provide emergency responders and industrial stakeholders an opportunity to work together and refine the tactical elements of emergency response plans.

Participating in the mock exercise along with Brunswick Pipeline and NB Power personnel will be members of the Saint John Fire Department, the Saint John Emergency Measures Organization, and other adjacent stakeholders.

Area residents may notice emergency response vehicles and increased activity during this time, but we do not anticipate any traffic disruptions or impact to local homes or businesses.
